2 Year Olds

This week the 2 Year Old Nursery has welcomed new starters. It has been a busy week full of learning through play. The topic in the Nursery this half term is winter. We will be focusing on snow and ice and developing our language and communication skills to describe how they feel and how they look. We will be developing our skills in physical development in finger gym activities and our gross motor skills during outdoor play

3 Year Olds

The children have welcomed new starters this term. They have settled into their new routine and they are thoroughly enjoying their new Nursery environment. The older children in the Nursery have been collaborating to ensure the new starters are settling in and they are being excellent role models. This half term the children are learning about winter and we are focusing on the book Polar Bear. Polar Bear. 
improve on our last scores that we achieved at the start of the year.




