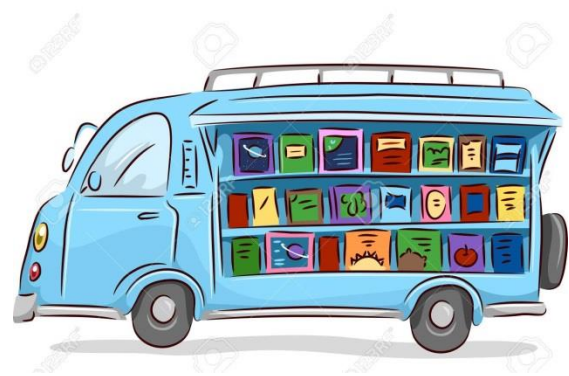
Year 1

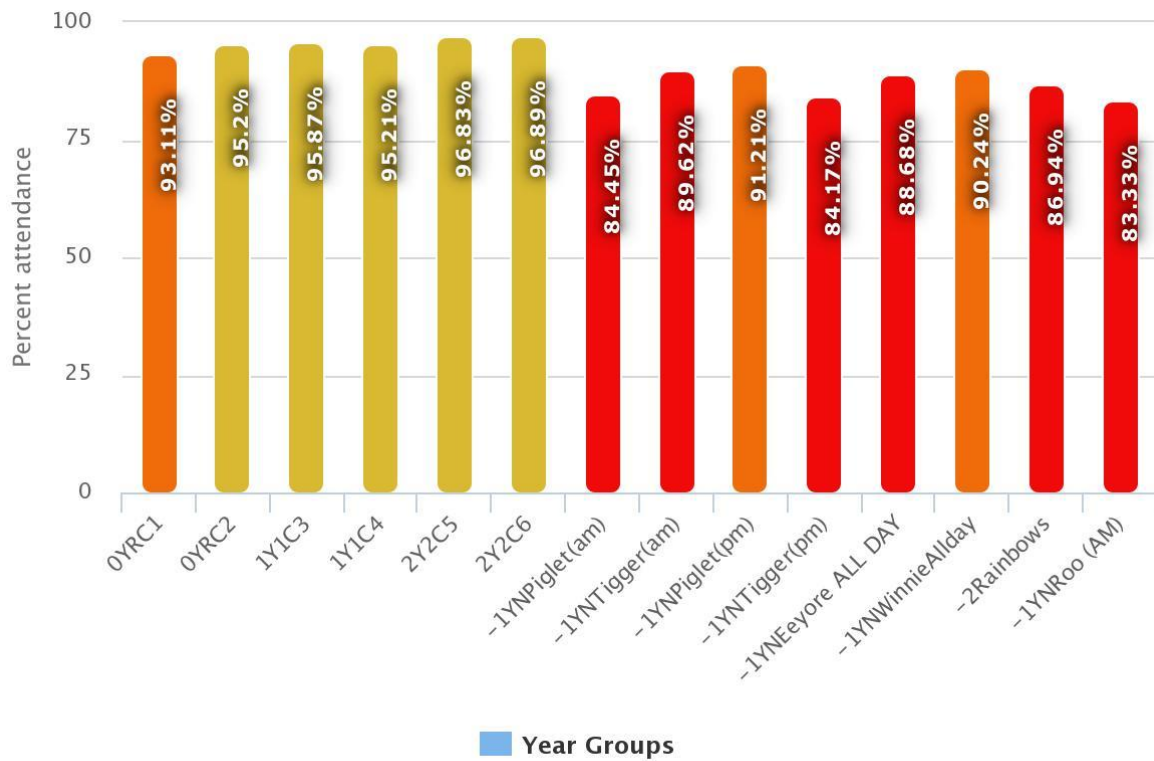

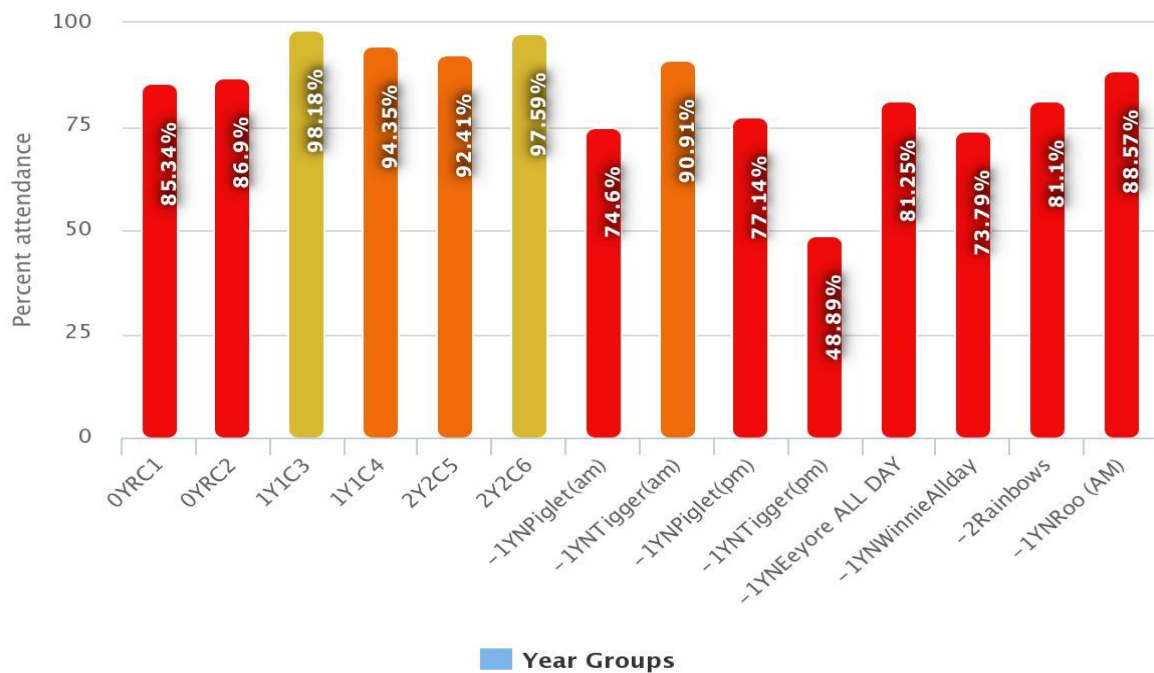


Attendance Matters
