Nursery

<u>2 Year Olds</u>

This week the 2 Year Old Nursery have been exploring our farm topic and have been imitating milking a cow in the water area, the children thoroughly enjoyed this. The children have been enhancing their fine motor skills by mark making they have been imitating drawing lines and circles. The children have been taking part in small group games playing some farm related games this is enhancing their communication and language skills.

<u>3 Year Olds</u>

The 3 year old nursery children have been enjoying trying new foods during breakfast week. They have been making choices and deciding what they would like eat. The children have been discussing their likes and dislikes during small group activities. The children have been using their noticing skills during mathematical activities to identify and describe 2D shapes. We have been focusing on circle. square, triangle and rectangle.

Reception

This week in Reception in our Understanding the World lessons the



children have been learning about growing based around our topic book 'The princess and the giant'. they have been labelling the

different parts of a plant and choosing the correct colours to decorate it. In their Expressive Arts and Design lessons the children have been creating masks of the giants face from the story using collage materials. The children have been learning about subtracting and addition in mathe. They have been counting all of the objects in two groups and using mathematical language to describe their number sentence. They have had daily RWI lessons where they have learned new sounds and practiced blending and segmenting words with Fred the frog to help them read they have also been practicing phase 3 tricky words. The children have had their weekly news lesson where they have been writing about what they have done over the weekend, using their phonic knowledge to sound out and write simple words and sentences, using capital letters and time markers independently. The children have been persevering with their pencil grip and letter formation in our handwriting lessons and have been practicing tracing and forming letters linked to their RWI learning. The children have had their weekly gymnastic lesson with Natalie. In their healthy movers session with Amy the children have been practicing sit ups, press ups and bowl sits. The children have taken part in their weekly PE lesson with Amy practicing their cricket skills. The children enjoyed their weekly singing lesson with Hannah where they have been singing and



exploring musical instruments. The children have had their weekly sketching lesson where they have used their noticing skills to sketch a picture of a beanstalk and collage it. The children have enjoyed trying different foods for breakfast every day, and they loved celebrating Pancake Day! The children all looked fantastic in their costumes for world book day and really enjoyed getting a new book too.

<u>Year l</u>

Year I have really enjoyed this week. We

have been like Lucy the Empathy and Listening Llama and discussed the good and bad things about zoos. We have continued our numbers to 40 and have been working



really hard. We even went on a trip to Kenyal The children loved seeing all the different animals and classifying them in different groups. We visited Lake Victoria and Mount Kenya. The children wrote all about this in their guided writing books. We were like Indi the Imaging Indian Elephant all week. Everyone in year I looked absolutely fantastic for World book day too.

<u>Year 2</u>

This week has been breakfast week, Year 2 have enjoyed a selection of different foods ranging from porridge to continental meats. The children who are taking part in Rock Challenge and U Dance have been continuing to work hard in their rehearsals. Classes 5 and 6 have both had a tennis session with Rob in which they have practicing their throwing and hitting skills using tennis rackets. On Thursday for World Book Day we had a super selection of fancy dress costumes and enjoyed sharing a selection of our favourite stories. As mathematicians we have been developing and deepening our knowledge of 2D shape, we have focused on lines of symmetry, making figures, sorting shapes and drawing shapes.




