Nursery

2 Year Olds

This week the children have been on a trip to Wellington



Farm for a picnic and to have a walk around the animal enclosure. The children all thoroughly enjoyed this and were able to identify all the different animals. The children have been exploring outdoors on our patio area, collaborating together building with the outdoor construction bricks to create simple structures

3 Year Olds

The 3 year old nursery children are using

their listening skills to discuss the story of Noah's Ark. The children have been using their imagination to move around like animals from the Ark. The children have been recreating



pictures of the Ark and discussing who they would like to take on the Ark with



them; just like Noah who took his family. The children have been persevering to develop their skills in physical development with Amy the mutliskills coach. They have been travelling in various ways and practising jumping and balancing.



<u>Reception</u>

This week in Reception in our "Understanding the World" lesson the children have been using their senses to taste different

foods like Nigel the Noticing Neut linked to our book the princess and the giant. In their Expressive Arts and Design lessons the children have been persevering to collage a leaf using different tools and materials. The children have been learning about subtraction in maths. they have been counting all of the objects in a group, taking some away and counting them to find out how many are left, and they have been using mathematical language to describe their number sentence. They have had daily RWI lessons where they have learned new sounds and practiced blending and segmenting words with Fred the frog to help them read, they have also been practicing phase 3 tricky words. The children have had their

weekly news lesson where they have been writing about what they have done over the weekend, using their phonic knowledge to sound out and write simple words and sentences, using capital letters and time markers independently. The children have been persevering with their pencil grip and letter formation in our handwriting lessons and have been practicing tracing and forming letters linked to their RWI learning. The children have had their weekly gymnastic lesson with Natalie. In their healthy movers session the children have been practicing throwing and catching. The children have taken part in their weekly PE lesson with Amy practicing cricket. The children enjoyed their weekly singing lesson with Hannah where they have been singing, and exploring musical instruments. The children have had their

weekly sketching lesson where they have used their noticing skills to sketch a picture of a budding plant.

During this week year I have been working on their multiplication and sharing into equal groups. All the children have been like Ronny the Reasoning Rhino being able to explain why the group are

equal. All the children have created their own food menu for a carnivore, herbivore and even an omnivore! They all found it very interesting.






