#### <u>Nursery</u>

#### 2 Year Olds

This week the 2 year old nursery have been making the most of the warm weather and have been playing outdoors on the patio in the sand and water tray. We have been observing daily our caterpillars growing and starting to build cocoon's. The children are all really fascinated watching the caterpillar's life cycle.

#### 3 Year Olds

The 3 year old nursery children have

welcomed some special visitors this week. We are observing and caring for a large group of caterpillars. The children have been introduced to the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and we have been discussing the life cycle of a butterfly. The children have been using



their noticing skills to identify the changes that are taking place. During Mathematics the children have been developing their pattern making skills to make caterpillars. You can see a selection of the caterpillars we have been making on display in our gallery.

## Reception

This week in Reception in our Understanding of the World lessons the children have been like Nigel the Noticing Newt on their litter pick around the school grounds, we then sorted the different pieces we found into the correct recycling bins. In

their Expressive Arts and Design lessons the children have been persevering to print patterns using recycled materials they have found and collected. The children have been learning about sharing in maths, they have been counting all of the objects in a group, and sharing them equally between two and three groups. The children used sweets to do this and enjoyed eating some afterwards! They have had daily RWI lessons where they have learned new sounds and practiced blending and segmenting words with Fred the frog to help them read, they have also been practicing phase 3 tricky words and have practiced reading some alien words. 
children have had their weekly news lesson where they have been writing about what they have done over the weekend, using their phonic knowledge to sound out and write

simple words and sentences, using capital letters and time markers independently. The children have been persevering with their pencil grip and letter formation in our handwriting lessons and have been practicing tracing and forming letters linked to their RWI learning. The children have had their weekly gymnastic/dance lesson with Natalie. The children have taken part in their weekly PE lesson with Amy practicing cricket. The children enjoyed their weekly singing lessons with Hannah and Mr Milner where they have been learning about musical notes! The children have had their weekly sketching lesson where they have been learning about the artist Picasso and have created their own pieces of work linked to Picasso and his drawings using shapes.

#### Year 1

This week Year I have been learning about how to talk to friends online. They have been like Murphy the Managing Distraction Mole and written their own set of rules to

follow: We have all enjoyed creating our character and writing a short description about them. In Jigsaw this week we have been talking about family and have drawn our own



family portrait, which we were able to take home and show our family! We also had lots of fun in Music, playing our Glockenspiels. In RE we have been looking more at Judaism too: Well done Year! for all your hard work.

#### .<u>Year 2</u>

Year 2 have continued to work on their fractions in mathematics. We have been looking at 1/2, 1/3 and 1/4.

In literacy we were being explorers like Russell to write a narrative piece about the badges he gained and what they were for. We looked closely at skills we were expected to use.

We have looked carefully at internet safety in ICT and how we can stay safe while using technology.




