This week the children have enjoyed


watching the caterpillar life cycle and we now have butterflies which the children enjoyed letting go and watching them fly away. The children



have been using their fine motor skills to practice their cutting skills to make a bumble bee.

<u>3 Year Olds</u>

The 3 year old nursery have been using their noticing skills to identify the changes that the caterpillars are undertaking. The children have been talking about the changes and the majority of them can confidently orally sequence the life cycle of a butterfly. The children have been persevering this week to develop their pencil grip and control. The children have been writing their names to make a name caterpillar. In multi-skills this week the children have been persevering to develop their ball control skills and hand eye coordination



Reception



This week reception have been very creative and made their own junk model superhero's linked to our topic book "George saves the world by lunchtime".

They recycled items to make their own recycling hero's like George. The children also made their own bug houses to keep bugs and animals safe. They made these using resources from outside. We have started rehearsing for our Summer Carnegie performance in dance with Natalie and are remembering the moves for our dance. We use our imitating skills to copy Natalie doing the moves. As mathematicians we have been learning how to share items between 2 and 3 people. They worked with their collaboration partners this week to share and group items. We have also begun to count in 2's and 5's so your child will be able to practice these at home!

<u>Year l</u>

This week has been a busy one in year one. In maths, we have been using our reasoning skills to compare numbers to 100 and have collaborated to find number patterns. In RE, we have been finding out more about Shabbat and we then used our imagination like Indi to write a retell about our Shabbat. In our ICT lesson this week, we have been learning all about positive communication. We have used our writing skills to rewrite a number of different text messages that include positive language and show that we can use our manners. We had a fur morning on Friday as we went out on the playground and used jumbo chalk to draw clocks and solve problems relating to time. On Friday afternoon, we set our butterflies free and watched as they flew off to start their new lives.

On Thursday the children had their first swimming lesson and are excited to continue with this next week. 
