Nursery

2 Year Olds

The children have been very busy this week using their Funky Fingers (fine motor skills) to make pictures with coloured pompoms. During snack time we have been buttering our own toast and pouring our own juice.

We have been reading Dear Zoo and using our mathematical language to describe an animal's size.

3 Year Olds

The children have been learning about autumn. They have been learning a

selection of action songs and they are thoroughly enjoying collaborating during singing time. The children have also been using the leaves they have collected to make leaf prints. The



children have been using their noticing skills to identify the colours they can see in autumn time and to identify the changes in the leaves.

Reception

This week in Reception we had lots of exciting opportunities. On Monday we had the opportunity to make sock puppets and watch a puppet show with Joe. We used our imagination and our communication and language skills to help us in the puppet workshop. On Wednesday we took part in the school Harvest assembly. We sang songs, listened to a poem and listened to Reverend Ian who came to speak to us about Harvest time. Throughout the weeks we have been learning 2 poems and we performed these at the poetry recital. We were all very brave to perform in front of all the grownups that came to watch. Also this week we have been doing our daily phonics lessons, daily handwriting, dance, music and P.E with Amy.

Year 1

We have had an exciting week in year l this week. As young mathletes, we have

begun to subtract numbers using the crossing out method and with resources. As scientists, we collaborated to design and make a house for the



three little pigs, using the materials that we thought would best protect them from the big bad wolf's breath. We then tested our houses and wrote up our findings. We had a great surprise when we had the opportunity to go into the hall and watch a puppet show. It was really funny and we got to see a rabbit do magic. On Thursday, we were very brave and became poets as we gave a poetry recital in the hall. On Friday we got to show our grown-ups some of the activities that we do in school to improve our literacy skills. On Friday afternoon, we went for a walk to Vulcan's Park to see the Cenotaph. Along the way, we discussed the natural and man-made features that we could see.

Year 2

Year 2 have had a busy week continuing with their learning. Within maths we have been deepening our skills of subtraction methods. During our topic and literacy lessons we created our own fossils. We had to carefully follow the instructions to ensure we correctly made the fossils. Following on we wrote our own set of instructions which somebody else would be able to follow.

As scientists we have been learning how to care for pets. We looked at a variety of household pets and used our absorbing skills like Anita the Ant eater to then create our own leaflet about caring for pets. We also thoroughly enjoyed performing our poems on Thursday and welcoming our parents into class on Friday.






