Reception

This week in Reception in our Understanding of the World lessons the children have received a letter from George and have been making posters and pieces of writing to explain what we have learned about the topic of recycling this half term. In their Expressive Arts and Design lessons the children have been persevering to make posters using recycled materials such as sweet wrappers and bottle tops. The children have been learning about money again this week in maths. We have been adding coins together to buy different items from the 'shop'. They have had daily RWI lessons where they have been recapping the phonemes they know and practicing blending and segmenting words with Fred the frog to help them read. They have also been practicing phase 3 and 4 tricky words and have practiced reading some alien words. The children have had their weekly news lesson writing about the things they have learned this half term linked to our topic work. The children have been persevering with their pencil grip and letter formation in our handwriting lessons, and have been practicing tracing and forming letters linked to their RWI learning. The children have had their weekly dance lesson with Natalie where they have continued to practice for the Summer Carnegie performance. They have also enjoyed their weekly singing lessons with Hannah. The children have also thoroughly enjoyed taking part in sports day and they all persevered to do their best!

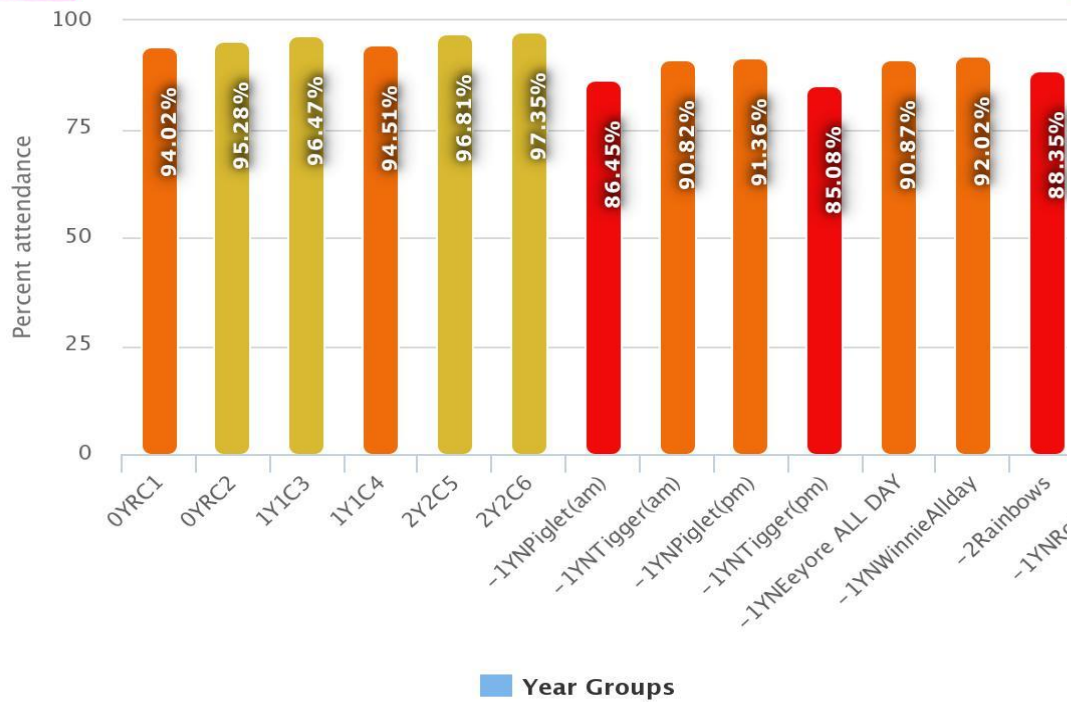

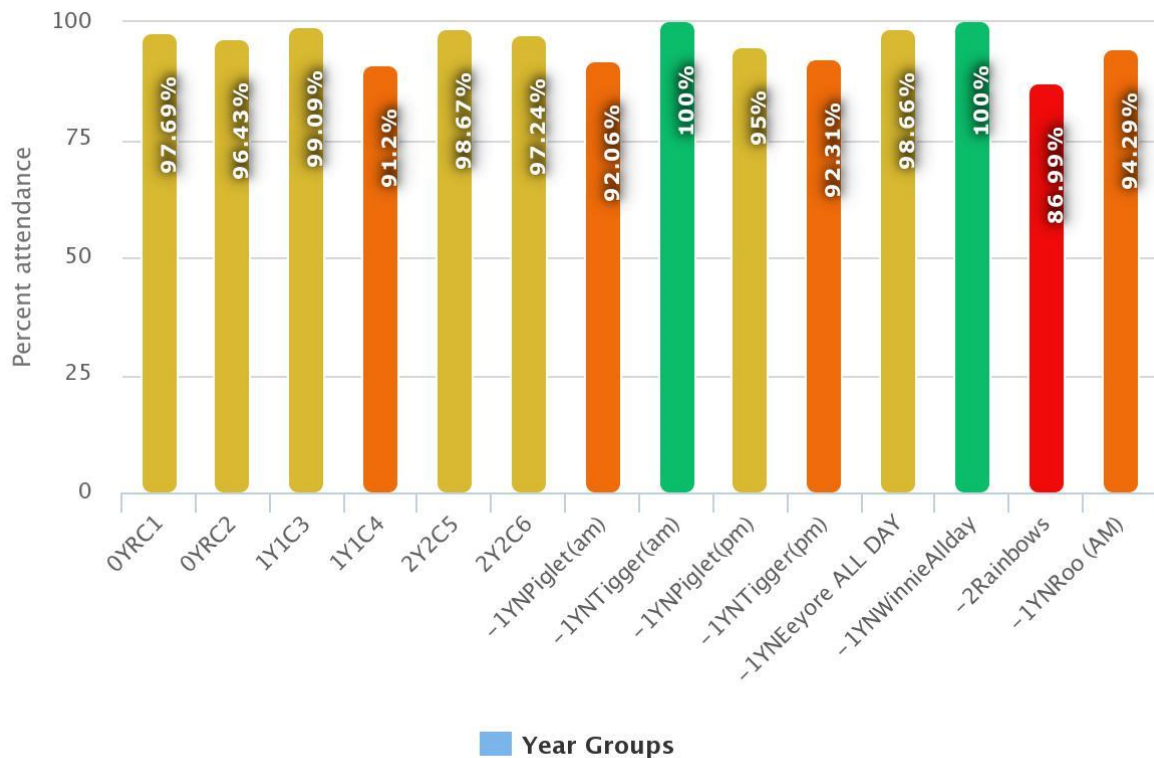




Whole School Attendance 3rd September – 17th May 2019
