The children have been enjoying the glorious sunshine! The children have been learning outdoors: developing their mark making and physical development skills. The children have a new outdoor music area (kindly made by Miss Relph) and they have thoroughly enjoyed exploring sound. Some of the children have formed a Nursery band. Reception

This week in Reception in our Understanding of the World lessons the children have been like Nigel the Noticing Newt looking at the properties of recycled materials and grouping them according to their properties. In their Expressive Arts and Design lessons the children have been persevering to collage recycling signs to put up around the school grounds. The children have been learning about money in maths, we have been learning about coins and their values and adding their values together. They have had daily RWI lessons where they have been recapping the phonemes they know and practicing blending and segmenting words with Fred the frog to help them read, they have also been practicing phase 3 and 4 tricky words and have practiced reading some alien words. The children have had their weekly news lesson, writing about releasing our butterflies on Friday. The children have been persevering with their pencil grip and letter formation in our handwriting lessons and have been practicing tracing and forming letters linked to their RWI learning. The children have had their weekly gymnastic/dance lesson with Natalie where they have continued to practice for the Summer Carnegie performance. The children have taken part in their weekly PE lesson with Amy. They have also enjoyed their weekly singing lessons with Hannah. The children have had their weekly sketching lesson where they have been imitating some of Picasso's paintings using their noticing skills. We have also been on the life bus learning all about our bodies and the important organs we need to live!









Whole School Attendance 3rd September - 10th May 2019
