We have had a very creative week this week in preparation for the Arts Exhibition on Friday. The children have enjoyed working with a range of textures and materials. We will be selling our enterprise items on Friday for parents to purchase.

We have played in the mud kitchen and made some very interesting meals for each other!!! Hopefully the weather will brighten up to enable us to do some more quality outdoors learning.



#### 3 Year Olds

The children have been focusing on special events for family members. The children have been making a card for someone special.

They have been persevering to make mark using different media and develop their skills in expressive arts and design. The children have really enjoyed collaborating to make art work for the Arts Exhibition. We hope you have all been to view the art on display.



### Reception

This week in Reception the children thoroughly enjoyed our trip to the Aquarium. they learned lots of facts about different sea creatures and loved playing on the 'Shiver me timbers' park too. In our Understanding of the World lessons the

children have been making cards for a special person, they used their noticing skills to copy a picture and persevered to write a message inside. In their Expressive Arts and Design lessons the children have been persevering to decorate their enterprise pieces for the art exhibition and have helped to make a model of St. Michael's church. The children have been learning about halving in maths and we have halved cakes and groups of objects. They have had daily RWI lessons where they have been recapping the phonemes they know and practicing blending and segmenting words with Fred the frog to help them read, they have also been practicing phase 3 and 4 tricky words and have practiced reading some alien words. The children have had their weekly news lesson, writing about their trip to the Aquarium. The children have been persevering with their pencil grip and letter formation in our handwriting lessons, and have been practicing tracing and forming letters linked to their RWI learning. The children have had their weekly dance lesson with Natalie where they have continued to practice for the Summer Carnegie performance. They have also enjoyed their weekly singing lessons with Hannah. Lots of the children have enjoyed showcasing their art work at the art exhibition and some even got their face painted!



## Year 1

This week in year 1 we have been doing research into William Lowther. We have collaborated to find out some information about him and we then used our art skills to draw a portrait of him. In RE this week, we have been finding out about Hanukkah. We collaborated in small groups to put pictures of the story of Hanukkah in the correct order, reminding each other of the key events and people who were involved such as the Maccabees. In literacy this week, we have all been actors as we carried out a freeze frame from one the scenes from our power of reading book. We then used this experience to write thought bubbles about what the characters might be thinking or feeling. We used our imagination and writing skills to continue a story suggesting what might happen to the dragon in our book once it had been put to sleep under the moonlight.

## Year 2



As young writers we have been using our imagination to write under the sea stories.


