
3 Year Olds

We found out about the


We found out about the different kinds of materials and where to find them by having a look around the school grounds then we talked about the different words to describe them. On Friday we were busy finding out about how

we can reduce, reuse, recycle and had a go at a few different activities whilst learning about how we can do our bit to help the world to be 'green'.




Whole School Attendance 3rd September - 16th June 2019
