#### 2 Year Olds

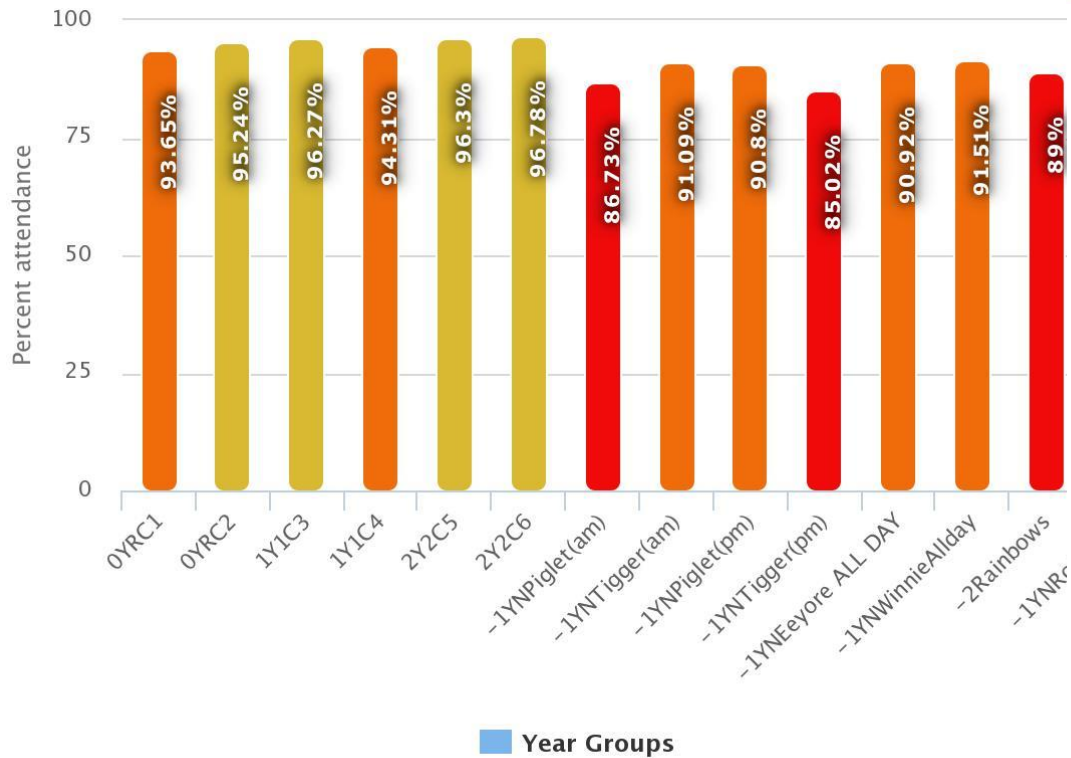
As mathematicians we have continued our work on fractions and time. Developing our skills in both of these areas.

We enjoyed another swimming session in which we developed our skills swimming both on our front and back.

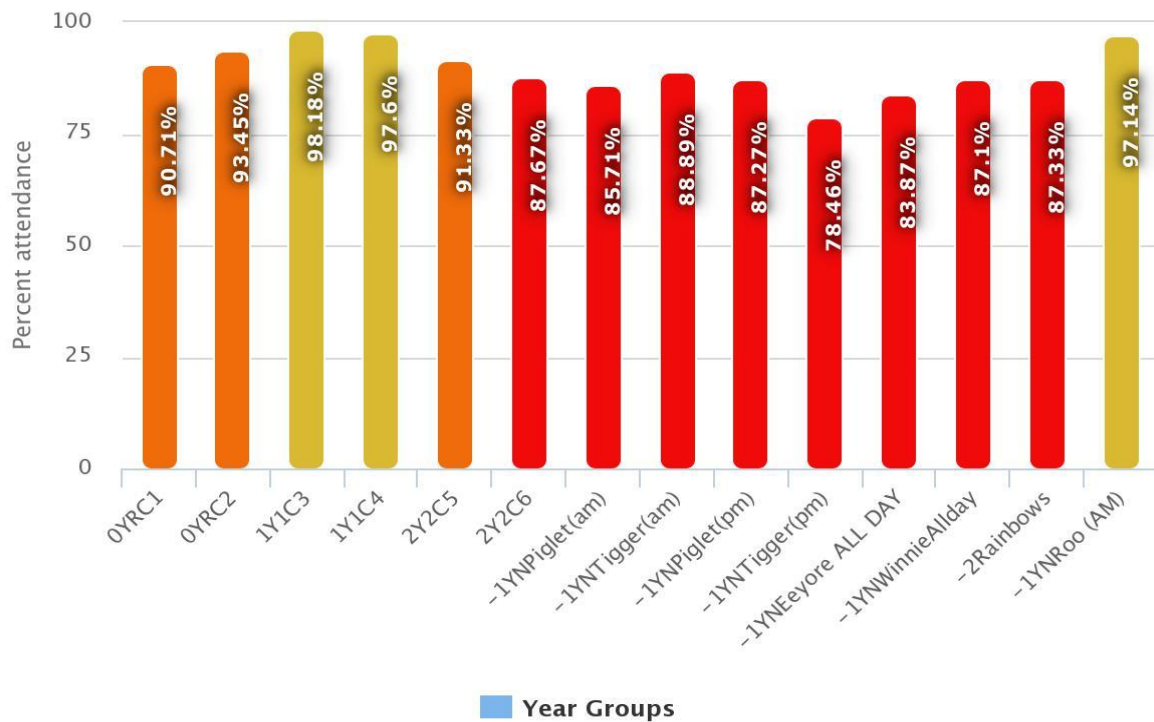
