2 Year Olds

This week the Rainbow nursery have been exploring the ice in the sensory tuff tray, we talked about the texture and observed how the ice melts. We used some food colouring in the ice trays and put it in the freezer. We were amazed to find the different coloured ice in the morning.

3 Year Olds

This week the 3 year old nursery children have been developing their noticing skills and making marks using conkers. The children have been identifying autumn colours and mixing these colours to make marks. The children have also been learning to recognise numerals 0-10. The

children are also using their noticing skills to look for numbers in the environment. The children are collaborating to prepare for the autumn poetry performance next week. We hope you can come along and join us

Reception

This week in Reception the children have enjoyed sharing their news in a circle time and have been developing their skills as an active listener. They have been practicing using their phonic knowledge to write about what they have been doing over the weekend. The children have been learning about numbers I to 5 in mathe lessons and have been learning about the properties of 2D shapes. In our Understanding of the World lessons the children have been melting and solidifying chocolate during a science experiment, then they made chocolate Elmer's linked to our topic book In our Expressive Arts and Design lessons the children have created pictures of their houses and the people who live there linked to our topic 'All about me'. The children have begun to practice their dance for the Christmas Carnegie performance with Natalie. In PE we have been practicing our throwing and catching skills with Amy and have been persevering to collaborate with our friends. We have enjoyed learning new songs with Hannah and have been playing some musical instruments. We enjoyed our Harvest festival with Reverend Peter on Wednesday. On Thursday we enjoyed a performance from the Mighty Zulu Nation and took part in a dance workshop. On Friday we loved sharing our Autumn Poems with our parents and carers.



<u>Year</u> 1

Year I have had another busy and exciting week. During our RE lesson this week we continued looking at Christian ceremonies in particular Baptism. We looked at what happens during this ceremony and why it is important to Christians. Following this we wrote invitations for a Baptism. As young mathematicians we have looked at addition within 10. The children came across different ways of adding 10. They have encountered the part-whole diagram and begin to lay the foundations of the inverse of addition. The Mighty Zulu Nation came to visit us. What an experience! We are very lucky to

be able to experience something so special.

Year 2

This week the Year 2 children have been creative and made their own Wild Thing using a selection of materials. Following on from this the children had to write a detailed character description to match their own 'Wild Thing'. Everyone has also worked hard to identify and write exclamations and questions correctly. During Science the children have created their own boat for Max (The main character from our Power of Reading book), to do this they investigated a variety of materials so they can could make informed decisions when making their own, we carried out a fair test to see which boats would be the most suitable for Max. During RE the children enjoyed listening to the story of 'Jesus healing the sick' then following on from this they created a lovely piece of artwork using pastels to represent the story. As mathematicians the children have continued their addition and subtraction work using their reasoning skills like Ronny to deepen their learning and support their peers.




