2 Year Olds

This week the Rainbow nursery has been learning about Bonfire night we watched some fireworks which the children thoroughly enjoyed. We have been using a fork and some paint to create our own firework pictures.

3 Year Olds

This week the 3 year old nursery children have been learning about Bonfire Night. They have been creating firework pictures and learning about fire safety. The children enjoyed a small firework display at school. They have also been learning about Remembrance Day and the importance of the poppy. The children have been collaborating to make a poppy to display and their own poppy to lay in assembly on Monday.

Reception

This week the Reception children have had lots of fun learning about bonfire safety and Remembrance day. They collaborated to create some amazing firework pictures using different resources. During an art lesson, the children used their drawing skills to create a poppy for the Remembrance assembly on Monday. During music with Hannah the children were moving in time with the music to be like fireworks. During our maths sessions the children have been counting and recognising numbers 7 and 8 and beginning to use language related to time. We read the book "The Man on the moon" to listen to Bob's morning and night routine.

Year 1

As young writers the children have enjoyed carrying on with the story The Lonely Beast. This week we have been exploring the way in which to write a detailed diary entry of the Beast's adventure through the sea and the different things he saw along the way. We were like Marvin the Making Links Monkey linking our ideas to the

events in the book. As scientists we explored the seasonal change in weather in the Autumn. We observed and described weather that is associated with the seasons.

In ICT we looked at debugging BEE-BOTs, we went back through our work to check for mistakes to be able to debug a program.

Through RE we have looked at all the different ways in which EID is celebrated.

Year 2

We have had a lovely week in year 2 making princess crowns based on our Power of Reading Book 'The Princess and the White Bear King' and describing them in Literacy. We have learned all about Remembrance Day and why we wear poppies. We even made our own! We made some lovely firework pictures using our noticing skills too. We are about to start chapter 4 in our Maths No Problem scheme, where we will learn how to divide! Please ensure you read with your child every night.
