2 Year Olds

This week the Rainbow nursery have been practising their threading skills by putting pasta on pipe cleaners, we have also been practising our Christmas Nativity songs. The children had a go at making their own snack and chose a topping for their toast.

3 Year Olds

This week the 3 year old nursery children have been learning about different materials and beginning to describe the texture of the materials. We are using the 'That's not my...' books to encourage the development of language and in particular using words to describe how things feel. The children have collaborated to explore the materials needed to create the display. The children are now beginning to get excited for Christmas!

Reception

This week the children have been learning all about road safety. They have had several assemblies about keeping safe, and spoke to a special visitor, Alison the PCSO. The children have continued to learn about their topic book "The jolly Christmas postman". They created their own post boxes and learnt about the pull and push force. They experimented with cars to think about when the postman was pushing and pulling his bike. In writing the children wrote their Christmas list for Santa, they had to think about using the correct format for writing a list. The children are very excited for their Carnegie performance next week!

Year 1

What a wonderful week Year I have had this week!
As young mathematicians we have continued to look at numbers 0-20.
We have studied comparing and ordering numbers.
As writers we have focussed on writing a short script identifying what the characters are saying for a news broadcast linked to our Power of Reading book 'The Lonely Beast. The children were like Cathy the

Capitalizing Cat to be resourceful to up level their writing.
As scientists we took ourselves outside to identify the different autumn features we can see in our own playground. We collected them up and created a collage.

<u>Year 2</u>

As young writers this week the children have written some superb character descriptions of the princess from our Power of Reading Book. The children have worked hard to include a range of adjectives in their writing to ensure it is interesting for the reader. In Maths we have been further embedding our learning around Multiplication and Division, the children have worked hard to be able to identify the inverse equations e.g. 2 x 10 = 20, 10 x 2 = 20, $20 \div 2 = 10$ and 20 ÷ 10 = 2. The children have been practicing their Carnegie performances with Natalie and look forward to their show next week
